

Autism Intervention Program

Program Outcomes:

- To provide a specialised programme to develop the individual identified skills of students with Autism in the Learning Centre
- To provide additional opportunities for students with Autism to access the curriculum in either a 1:1 or an intensive small group (separate to the class program settings)

Student Outcomes will be:

- Determined by discussions between the program teacher and the student's class teacher/s
- Informed by parent requests during IEP meetings and through a completed parental survey / form (Sensory Checklist)

Assessment:

Initial assessment for each student is based on:

- The ASD Program teacher's report
- Sensory Checklist

Specific data relating to the individual IEP Outcomes is collected by the Program teacher during each session. Data is reviewed at the end of each term and a Program Report is shared with the class teachers. Reporting on the individual IEP Outcomes occurs at the end of each semester in the student's IEP Report.
