## Welcome to your P & C:

The P & C is a joint body of both the Coolbellup Community School and the Coolbellup Learning Centre.

The P&C consist of individual parents and carers of students enrolled in both schools. The P & C committee is made up of elected members and consists of a President, Vice-President, Secretary/Treasurer and a number of committee members.



The P&C holds its AGM every March and meets regularly twice a term. The P&C's annual membership fee is set at \$1.00. The P&C supports the schools in many ways including graduation, fundraising & input into school decision making. It also provides a representative to the joint Schools' Council.

## FUNDRAISING

The P&C, amongst its other roles, raises money for the schools. Annual events for Mothers' & Fathers' Day, Easter raffles and additional events each year help raise the bulk of funds. Each year the P&C ask the schools to suggest projects to fundraise for. Previous purchases include, K/PP area play equipment, a floor rug for the library reading corner, Reading Eggs subscriptions and numerous class and graduation book prizes. In addition they contribute to joint school events such as the Seniors School Camp, EDUdance and other activities where the schools require assistance.



## P&C: SPONSORED PROGRAMS

The P&C have a number of ongoing fundraising programs that raise money through commissions and points programs when you shop. These include the Scholastics Book Club, and the Hilton Gilberts Fresh SOS Program.



## THE UNIFORM SHOP

The P&C runs the uniform shop for both schools. Summer and winter styles are available in the schools' colours of jade green and black.

The uniform shop is located in the Community Room in the Undercover Area and is open every Monday and Friday mornings at 8.30– 9.00am.
